MINUTES DAVIE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2020

The Davie County Board of Education met at 4:00 p.m., June 2, 2020, via Zoom due to COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

Chairman Junker called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m.

Dub Potts made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

Paul Drechsler made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2020 regular Board of Education meeting as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

Board Report

Chairman Junker reviewed upcoming events which included Davie County Schools student's last day being Wednesday, June 10, 2020. Also Davie County High School's Drive-In Graduation will be on Saturday, June 13, 2020 starting at 8:30 a.m. Lastly, the next regular board of education meeting will be Tuesday, July 7, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Wallace started by congratulating Davie County Early College High School Class of 2020. Their graduation was held May 16, 2020 and the event showed the tremendous effort put forth by Denise Absher, Early College staff, and the Technology Department. Davie County High School's graduation will be a drive-in ceremony on June 13, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Mr. Wallace thanked Doyle Nicholson, principal of DCHS, for standing on his feet for over 14 hours over a 2 day period for the class of 2020 to walk and receive their diploma covers as a photo opportunity. The extra effort of all staff members is not unnoticed.

Mr. Wallace and other superintendents were told to expect guidance from CDC and DHHS regarding returning to school in the fall. The updated guidelines should be given out next week to those superintendents. Mr. Wallace is part of a re-opening committee for DPI and he has developed a re-opening committee for Davie County Schools as well. Once that committee for Davie County Schools develops a rough draft for re-opening, it will be presented to Suzanne Wright, Dr. Hirata, and John Eller to make sure the draft aligns with those county departments and to gain advice. Mr. Wallace is getting a strong sense that PPE (personal protective equipment) will be needed to re-open schools in the fall. For students and staff who are immune-compromised or are high risk, a virtual school will be offered to those affected. Details still need to be determined.

Davie County Schools staff is working on summer learning plans which is due June 22, 2020. A possible secondary level of summer remediation plan is in the works as well. Mr. Wallace stated we are moving toward a 1:1 device plan in Davie County Schools for grades 6 to 12. Erin Foil will be working closely with Curriculum and the Technology departments during this transition. We need about 2,500 more devices to reach this goal.

Mr. Wallace and county leaders met with YadTel to discuss getting 100% connectivity to the internet in the whole county. This would benefit schools, the health industry, and other businesses in the county.

Jennifer Swofford, principal at Mocksville Elementary, and Denise Absher, principal at Early College, are both resigning from Davie County Schools moving on to their next adventures. Both are leaving the school system in good standing and we wish them the best in their endeavors.

Mr. Wallace spoke on the board of commissioners work session regarding budget/funding he attended and said it was a very positive meeting. Any monies from the CARES Act will not be put in the fund balance. From the savings that have occurred due to COVID-19 closure, monies will be used for additional expenses related to the start of school. Examples of those savings include funds from not using buses as often, not using substitutes, and not using utilities as much.

Lastly, Mr. Wallace recognized the 2019-2020 Character Education winners for all the schools, the students selected for Governor's School, and Parker Prysianzniuk for being selected for the Morehead-Cain Scholarship.

Consent Agenda

Mr. Wallace stated that the board members received an email at 3:37 p.m. with an addendum to the personnel report and that they will be voting on that addendum as well. Terry Hales made the motion, seconded by Paul Drechsler, to approve the consent items as presented. The motion carried 7-0. Consent items approved: School Nutrition Contract Extensions for 2020-2021 school year, Alternative School Accountability Model, AIG Plan 2019-2022 Addendum, Donations Report, Surplus Property Report, Budget Amendments, Resolution Granting Authority to the Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer to Implement June 2020 Budget Amendments, FY20-21 Continuing Budget Resolution, FY20-21 Capital Outlay Fund Budget Resolution, Personnel Recommendations and the Personnel Report Addendum.

- b. Amounts may be transferred not to exceed three percent of the total budget between functions of the same fund with a report of such transfers being required at the next meeting of the Board of Education.
- c. Amounts may not be transferred between funds nor from any contingency appropriation within a fund.

Copies of the Budget Resolution shall be immediately furnished to the superintendent and the school finance officer for direction in carrying out their duties.

The Davie County Board of Education hereby authorizes the Superintendent of said district to continue the operation of said district as follows:

Local Current Expense Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2019-2020 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

Federal Grants Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2019-2020 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

Child Nutrition Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2019-2020 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

Other Special Revenue Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2019-2020 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

This resolution shall be effective July I, 2020 until a formal budget is adopted by the Davie County Board of Education.
