Did you know that the 2021-22 School Calendar has been amended?

At the December meeting, the Board of Education approved a recommendation to convert January 21 and June 9 from student instructional days to required teacher workdays. See the revised calendar [HERE](#). While seriously considering the loss of instructional time, the district leadership team and literacy coaches also realize the time needed for professional development, especially K-5 teachers who are participating in ~85 hours of required literacy training.

We do not want classified staff to be negatively impacted by this calendar amendment. Therefore, teacher assistants will still work on January 21 and June 9 as originally planned. Other classified staff should work with their direct supervisors on plans for these two dates.
