- b. Amounts may be transferred not to exceed three percent of the total budget between functions of the same fund with a report of such transfers being required at the next meeting of the Board of Education.
- Amounts may not be transferred between funds nor from any contingency appropriation within a fund.

Copies of the Budget Resolution shall be immediately furnished to the superintendent and the school finance officer for direction in carrying out their duties.

Child Nutrition Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2018-2019 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

Other Special Revenue Fund: Approved to expend funds up to but not to exceed the expenditure level of the 2018-2019 budget year, except for salaries and benefits. Salaries and benefits shall reflect any increase granted employees paid from the North Carolina State Public School Fund.

This resolution shall be effective July 1, 2019 until a formal budget is adopted by the Davie County Board of Education.
